
Wild Animal Characteristics Project - 3rd 9 Weeks Project due: January 19, 2024

For this project students are completing a ½ poster about which animal characteristics they would choose for themselves to have. Use a picture of your student big enough to add the characteristics they choose. They will choose eyes, nose, ears, teeth, and feet.

Encourage your student to be creative in their work. Use any materials you have at home to create the characteristics and attach to the picture on the poster board. An example has been included for clarity.


Research different animal characteristics with your student by watching videos and reading books. Perhaps visit your local library and check books out together! There is a great series of books all about what it would be like to have different animal characteristics. There are tons of read aloud videos available on youtube of other teachers reading these books.

Instructions

- 1. Research animal characteristics by reading book or watching videos.
 - 2. Glue a large picture of your student to a half poster board
- Use items from home to create animal characteristics to attach to the picture of your student (see example)
 - Students need eyes, ears, nose, teeth. and feet
- 4. Use provided sentence stems to give reasons for why each characteristic was chosen.
